

Community Projects with Island Voices



In addition to their intrinsic value as records of authentic Gaelic speech, these videos have also contributed significantly to allied projects led by partner universities, such as Automatic Speech Recognition ([ASR](#)) for Gaelic at the University of Edinburgh, and the Digital Archive of Scottish Gaelic ([DASG](#)) at the University of Glasgow, and stimulated comparative sociolinguistic discussion with international partners from India to Jamaica.

[Soillse](#) and the linked University of the Highlands and Islands [Language Sciences Institute](#) have developed a number of islands-based community recording projects over the past 5-7 years, with an emphasis on Empathetic Ethnography – capturing island residents’ memories, attitudes and opinions in their own words. Using the already existing online community platform of the “Island Voices/Guthan nan Eilean” Language Capture and Curation project, these recordings have been shared both within the islands and internationally. Many are supplemented with online wordlinked “Clilstore” transcripts, or auto-translatable Closed Caption subtitles, or both.
